Good Friday Service April 6, 2007



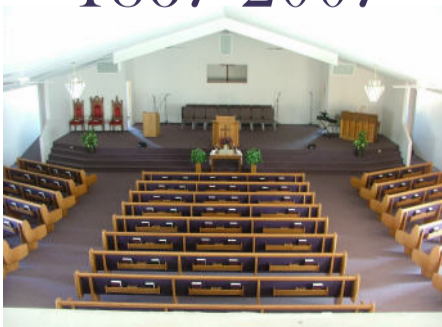
Our Good Friday communion service will be held at 7:00 on Friday, April 6.
